Base Honolulu is a restricted access environment. Each adult in the car will have to have official government issued identification. All cars can be checked for current registration, insurance, and inspection, so you must have all pertinent documents. If you have an expired driver’s license, it will be confiscated.

Waiting Area

- 1) Team waiting area will be on the grassy area on the south side of the pool. **No chairs, tables, or tents will be provided, but teams are allowed to bring whatever they need to be comfortable.** Visitors are required to stay in the immediate area of the event and cannot leave the competition area to tour the base.
- 2) The practice day will take place regardless of weather. In the unlikely event of severe weather, USCG volunteers will contact school POC’s with updates.
- 3) Nearby, at the Club 14 lanai, there will be a charging station and a technical support table. Teams will not be allowed to run extension cords to their team waiting areas. No other power or spare parts will be available.

Spectators

Students and other children will NOT be allowed in the swimming pool, only on the pool deck. All of the “in the water pool activity” will be conducted by adult volunteers. Parents can come onto the grassy area next to the pool deck to watch. We ask that spectators cycle through during their school’s practice time to allow all to see. **No chairs will be allowed on the pool deck.** Accommodations will be made for people with special needs. Please realize it is an underwater competition, so polarized sunglasses help reduce glare.
